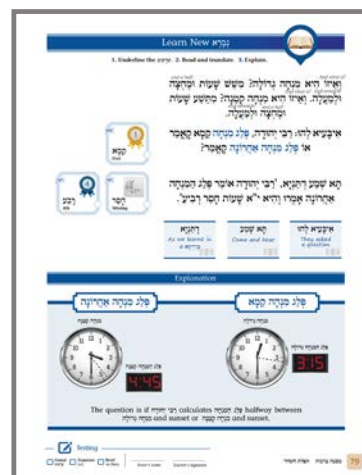
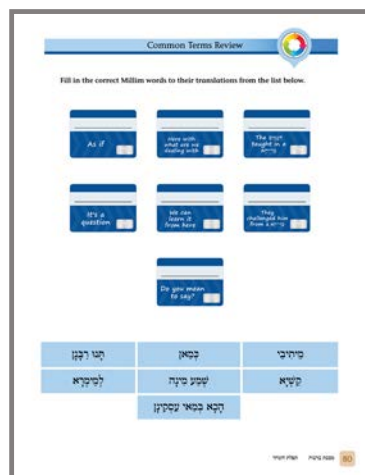


ADVANCE ORGANIZERS

Gemara includes many concepts that students may be unfamiliar with. The Children's Gemara prepares students ahead of every unit with visual images and explanations of upcoming concepts, and relevant sources from the Chumash.

ARAMAIC LANGUAGE ACTIVITIES
